



Dr Amrish Baliarsing and his team conducted ISRM 2018, which had rich scientific and cultural content. It was conducted in one of the most iconic hotels of Mumbai. Following is the highlights of the meeting as given by the Organising Secretary Dr Nilesh Satbhai.

Pre-conference Operative Video Workshop on 16th March 2018

Pre-conference Operative Video Workshop was conducted at the Taj Lands End Hotel, Bandra, Mumbai on 16 March 2018

The course comprised of edited videos on microsurgical operative procedures by eminent faculty from India and abroad. Number of participants was 186.

Video operating lecture topic included Free groin flap for the burns reconstruction, SCIP flap, Proximal peroneal artery perforator flap, Maxilla and midface reconstruction, Suprathin ALT flap, Fabricated TDAP flap in head and neck reconstruction, Double functioning free muscle transfer for Brachial plexus palsy, Planning of fibula osteotomies for mandible reconstruction, Microvascular transfer of Ileocolon for simultaneous reconstruction of esophagus and voice, Pharyngo-esophageal reconstruction - technical pearls, Laparoscopic assisted right gastroepiploic lymph node flap transfer for congenital lower limb lymphedema, Vascularized lymph node transfer, Medial femoral condyle flap for scaphoid nonunion, Modelling the fibula for maxilla Reconstruction: tips and tricks, CAD-CAM design for mandibular reconstruction, Deep inferior epigastric perforator flap for breast reconstruction, Transverse upper gracilis flap, Single stage facial reanimation with gracilis FFMT with masseter nerve and Temporalis transfer for eye closure in late facial nerve palsy and Profunda artery perforator flap. Video lectures provided detailed account of the steps of complex reconstructions.

In addition to the video workshop, two more hands on workshops were conducted on 16th March 2018.

Workshop on Venous coupling device for Microvascular Anastomosis

The workshop was conducted by Dr. Venkat Ramakrishnan. Dr. Shivprasad Date and Dr. Parag Telavane were moderators for this hands-on workshop. This workshop comprised of lectures, video viewing of the procedure and demonstration of the procedures. Microvascular anastomosis of veins using venous coupling device was demonstrated to the participants. All the participants practiced and successfully used the Venous coupling device to perform microvascular anastomosis of veins on porcine veins. Fifty-two delegates including trainees participated in this course.

Workshop on Mandible Reconstruction

The workshop was conducted by Dr. Giorgio De Santis, Dr. Samir Kumta, Dr. Charudatta Chaudhary, and Dr. Quazi Ahmed. Moderators for this workshop were Dr. Tushar Thorat and Dr. Tarush Gupta. This workshop comprised of lectures, video viewing of the procedure and demonstration of the procedures. All the participants practiced and successfully performed osteotomy of fibula and fixation using reconstruction plate for mandible reconstruction with use of bone saw model. Forty-six delegates including trainees participated in this course.

- 1. President Dr. Amrish Baliarsing welcomed the members and called the meeting to order.
- 2. Minutes of the 2016 ISRM general body meeting held at Kochi was passed.
- 3. Professor G.Balakrishnan gave the trustee report.
- 4. Dr. Hari Venkatramani presented the executive committee report.
- 5. New members admitted from 2016 2018 were welcomed and there were no objection found to any membership.
- 6. Dr. S.Raja Sabapathy and Dr.V. Purusothaman called for augmentation of Godina oration fund which was currently 5.31 Lakhs.
- 7. Prof. G. Balakrishnan and Dr. Prabha Yadav was called for augumention of international fellowship fund.
- 8. From the next ISRM (2020), there will Prof. Mukunda Reddy oration. The guidelines and criteria of selection for this oration would be prepared by committee headed by the president, Vice president and Dr. R. Shrikanth.

WSRM 2019 - Bologna, Italy

For the first time ever the WSRM Meeting occurred in Italy. Prof Giorgio De Santis, Chief of the Division of Plastic Surgery of University of Modena and Reggio Emilia were the hosting person and Congress Chairman, and Prof Marco Innocenti chaired the Scientific Committee.

The meeting turned out to be a great success:more than 1,600 microsurgeons from 64 countries participated, and more than half were under 40 years old This aspect has been very much rewarding for us and for the Society because it indicates a favorable trend for the future.

The most qualified experts from all over the world provided their contributions in all specific fields, and the three - days scientific program was outstanding. The theme of the Congress was "Ad Augusta per Angusta" which means "Great Achievements through narrow paths" which synthesizes the spirit and the essence of microsurgery.

Five Invited Lectures, twelve Instructional Courses, eighteen keynote lectures were delivered by the most distinguished experts in the world. After this, 66 panel sessions, selected free papers and free papers allowed for covering all hot topics of Microsurgery.

Indian participation: There was a big Indian delegation which actively participated in all delebration. Dr Hardeep Singh was the winner of the 'Master of the Disaster' session.
